

# HOUSE NURSING CAUCUS MEMBERS

In January 2003, Representatives Lois Capps (D-CA) and Ed Whitefield (R-KY) established the House Nursing Caucus after successfully signing the Nurse Reinvestment Act into law and securing the bill's funding.
